Additional information

- Oversized loads will use the entire width of a two-lane highway including the shoulder, and will be slow moving.
- Pilot vehicles and flag persons will travel with the loads to control traffic and enhance safety. Motorists travelling behind the loads may face brief delays.
- Government of Alberta policy requires oversized loads to pull over periodically when travelling at a speed of more than 10 km/h below the speed limit.
